_____ 4. Gift of securities

The most tax-effective way by which to make a gift to St. James is through a gift of securities such as stocks, bonds or mutual funds, particularly when there has been capital appreciation in the security; investment growth is not taxed when securities are donated to a registered Canadian charity such as St. James Westminster Church. Individuals who make this form of gift usually do so as their one-time gift to St. James for the year or as a special gift for a particular purpose. A separate form is available from the St. James Church office or the webpage to assist you in arranging a gift of securities.

Individuals may also wish to make a donation using visitor envelopes available in the pews or by providing a cheque or cash to the church in an envelope with the name and address of the envelope indicated. Such gifts are also eligible for a tax receipt.
